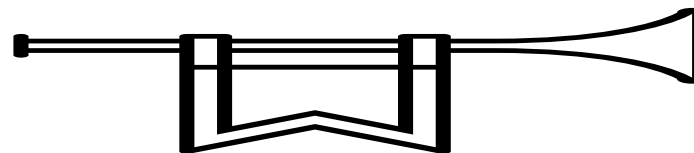

Special Business Meeting July 25, 2021

We will have a business meeting immediately following the worship service [on July 25](#). In order to more simply comply with the IRS' tax rules for Pastor Luke's tax withholdings, as a formality, the congregation has to vote to *officially* “license” him as Main Street Baptist Church's Pastor. This is a Pastoral License (noun) that, moving forward, MSBC will own in order to license (verb) its Ministers. This licensing formality will change nothing in terms of an MSBC Pastor's responsibilities or duties. It should however, make tax season a little less challenging.
