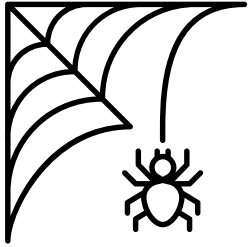
**HELP FREE CLOTHES AND MORE
