

CHRISTIAN RADIO

So, how many of you listen to Christian radio? We are fortunate, in this area, to have two stations that most of us can tune in. One is in Montrose, WPEL, which can be found at 96.5FM and 800AM on your dial. THE LEMANS

The Lemans, who work through Wycliffe to help translate the Bible into heart languages, report that many translations have been made and many more are in the works to reach people groups who haven't had Bibles in their native tongue. God is at work through this effort, and Marcus travels extensively to that end or works online in consultation with those in the field. Marcus and his wife Rachel and their 4 children ask for prayer for safety in travel, peace in the family when one or both parents are away, and they request prayer for more partnerships to help with the financial support that they need. They have been a part of our mission budget for a few years now.

CRU CAMPUS MINISTRY

Tom Rodriques and his wife are active in ministry at Queens college in New York City. This is a difficult place to minister, and they have been pushed aside by many when they try to tell students and professors about Jesus and his Salvation. It is often a one-on-one ministry due to the resistance to the Gospel that is experienced there.

There is a Fall retreat conference happening soon, and they are hoping for 100 students to come to it to build trust and friendship as a catalyst for their faith to grow to maturity. The couple also lead mission trips in the summer and greet incoming students with the hope of the Gospel. God is at work through them and we are glad to be a part of their ministry as we help support them through our Mission budget. They also need prayer for safety, and patience, and reliance on the Holy Spirit as they continue in this ministry.
