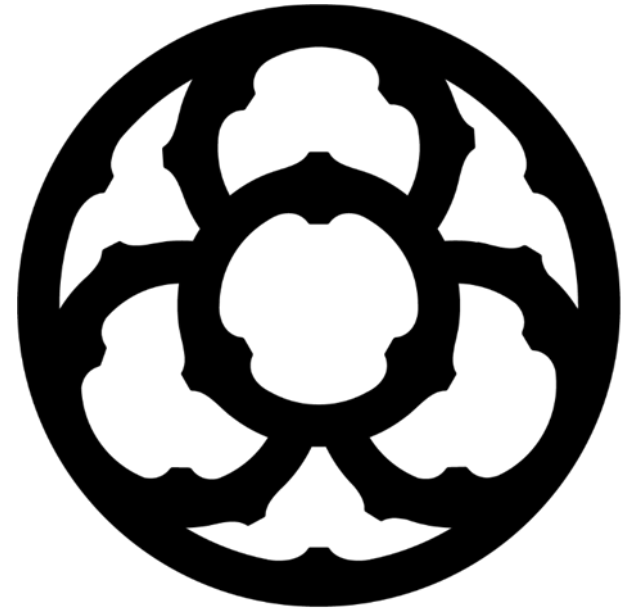
August 20th, Pastor's Book Club – Augustine's Confessions Book X
