### Apostles' Creed

I believe in God the Father Almighty,

 Suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
 Was crucified, dead, and buried;

 From thence he shall come to judge the living and the dead.

 The holy catholic\* church,  
 The communion of saints,

\* *catholic* means both "universal" and "according to the whole." To believe in the holy catholic church is to believe in one universal body of Christ encompassing all true Christians from all times and places which is built according to the whole witness of the Apostles, i.e. the entirety of the Scriptures.
