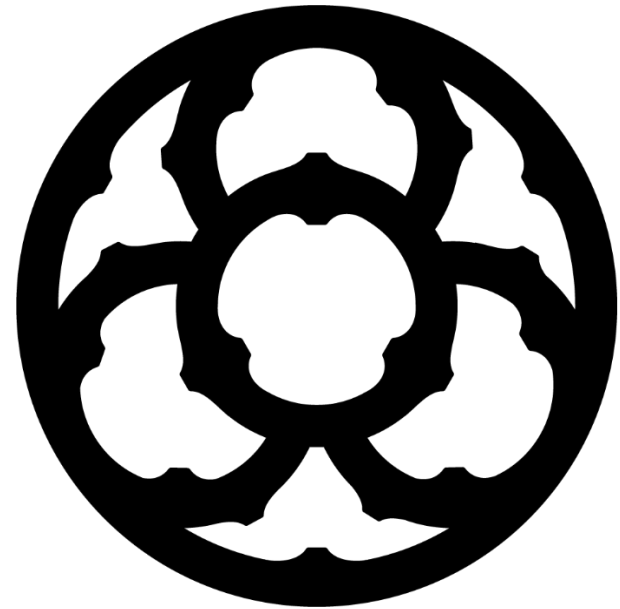

**you have loosed my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness,**






